During this month God blessed some of the children from the Colonia 89 with backpacks and with some school supplies for this new school year. As you may already know, the community in which we are serving the Lord is a very impoverished community. The reality of this community is that many of the families struggle to make ends meet; many services like having water every day, having light and a flushing toilet are a luxury that these families can't afford so it is needless to say that putting their children through school is out of the question for many of these families. As a ministry we try to help with sponsorships for some of the children in order for them to finish their schooling; unfortunately we do not have the resources necessary to put the many boys and girls that live in the Colonia 89 through school, but we pray and ask the Lord for His provision and in deed the Lord provides. The back packs and school supplies that we gave out this August were a part of the Lord's provision through our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. There are many children that are in need of school supplies that unfortunately we weren't able to supply them all with a back pack full of school supplies, but we are still praying and if God provides we will continue to share the blessing. Please join us in prayer for the children of the Colonia 89, pray for those that have the opportunity to start a new school year but especially pray for those that will be forced to work or take care of their younger siblings in order to help their family.

During the month of August God gave us the amazing blessing of praying for Enrique as he headed off to the New Tribes Missions Bible Institute in Chihuahua for his second year. As mentioned in other newsletters, the Lord allowed us to meet Enrique when he was a 16 year old teenager; at the time Enrique was struggling to stay away from the many bad influences of the local gang members of the Colonia 89. His mother Maria de Jesus started attending the bible classes and services in Dios Me Ve and she brought along Enrique. Time passed and Enrique kept listening to the teachings during which the Lord was working in His heart. Eventually Enrique made the decision of giving his life to Christ; he got baptized and started serving at Dios Me Ve. As Enrique got closer to the end of high school the Lord placed in his heart the desire to go to the New Tribes Missions Bible Institute in Chihuahua where now, at the age of 20, he has started his second year of schooling and is getting prepared to serve the Lord where ever He may send him. Our prayer is that Enrique may be the first of many other young boys and girls that will take the decision of serving the Lord with their life. Please keep Enrique in your prayers as he goes about doing the Lord's will for his life in a city where he has neither family nor friends; pray that he may remain encouraged and always focused on our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.



This August the Lord also gave us the privilege to travel and serve Him in Chihuahua, Mexico. We were blessed to receive the invitation to go out to the New Tribes Missions Bible Institute in Chihuahua and join the teachers, students and fellow brothers and sisters in Christ for their introduction week. On the 13th of August, just a few days after we sent Enrique off to Chihuahua we hopped on our vehicle and drove down there ourselves. The purpose of our visit was to partake in an introductory class of the book of firm foundations, to share a time of fellowship with our brothers and sisters in Christ and to encourage the students to continue to follow the Lord's will for their lives. Our time there was short but incredibly blessed as the Lord spoke to our hearts and the hearts of many others. During our visit it was also a great blessing to see how the teachers of the Bible Institute were eager to learn and to get to know the students in order to better prepare them to do the Lord's will. The Lord has given each of the students a different vision, some want to be missionaries and others pastor or leaders but our prayer is that in which ever path the Lord may lead them and whatever they do may bring honor and glory to His name. Please pray for strength, courage, and provision for all of our brothers and sisters in Christ that are around the world fulfilling the calling that the Lord has given them.
